

Ultrasound Report

Patient: Stray queen (unknown age)

Status: Late-term pregnancy

Findings:

- Ultrasonographic examination reveals a late-stage gravid uterus containing approximately 3–4 fetuses.
- Cervix is partially dilated.
- There is marked reduction in fetal fluids (amniotic/allantoic fluid), likely secondary to trauma.
- One fetus is confirmed dead (no detectable heartbeat).
- Remaining fetuses show very weak cardiac activity, indicating severe fetal distress.

Assessment:

- Fetal distress with one confirmed fetal death
- Partial cervical dilation with fluid loss
- High risk to both fetuses and the queen

Recommendation:

Immediate emergency cesarean section (C-section) is strongly indicated to attempt to save the remaining viable fetuses and to preserve the life of the queen, as delay may lead to severe complications including infection, sepsis, or death.
